Madam Ng was born in Singapore in 1932. She was adopted when she was young and her adoptive parents never sent her to school. As an adult, Madam Ng could not find a job. She decided to work as a Samsui woman.

Like most Samsui women in Singapore in the past, Madam Ng did not get married. She was beyond the ideal age of marriage by the time she started work. She supported herself by working at construction sites. She also wore a bright red headscarf or 'hong toujin'.

Today, at 85 years old, Madam Ng is retired and lives in a flat im Redhill. She is still healthy and cheerful, and does not let her age slow her down. She earns money by selling used cardboard that she collects from the neighbourhood.

Once a week, she goes to the Apex Club of Singapore where she receives a food package. She is grateful to the young volunteers there. Although she lives a simple life now, she chooses to see the brighter side of her situation. She feels fortunate that she is still in good health.
